Re: FERC Tariff No. 96

Dear Secretary Bose:

The accompanying tariff is sent to you for filing in compliance with requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Commission regulations. This tariff is issued by Explorer Pipeline Company ("Explorer") and bears the designation as FERC No. 96. The tariff is filed to become effective October 1, 2009. Explorer's tariff filings are based on its market-based authority granted by the Commission in Docket OR99-1-000, issued June 30, 1999 (87 FERC ¶ 61,374). For the ease to our Shippers, Explorer has maintained one tariff structure, which includes both intrastate (non-jurisdictional) and interstate rates (FERC jurisdictional).

FERC Tariff No. 96 contains the following additions and revisions to Explorer's FERC Tariff No. 95:

- New Item No 116, p. 19 – Jet Fuel Volume Incentive Rates to Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport (Tarrant County) incents committed jet fuel volume to the DFW International Airport;
- New Part II - Table of Jet Fuel Volume Incentive Rates, p. 22, reflect volume incentive rate for two-year committed volume;
- Part IV – Table of Specialty Product Rates, p. 25, is revised to cancel the additional charge to move the heavier specialty products, such as Grade 80, Light Cycle Oil; and
- Part V – Table of Bid Rates reflects no bid rates received for the month of October, 2009.


The tariff supplement is filed on short notice to become effective October 1, 2009 on 7 days notice pursuant to 18 CFR § 341.14 and § 6 of the Interstate Commerce Act. Short notice is due to Shippers requests for volume incentive program and decrease in certain specialty

product rates being effective on October 1, 2009. Explorer understands that this supplement is conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a 30-day review period.
