Re: F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 100.125.0 cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 100.124.0 (Docket No. IS24-803-000).

Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

The accompanying tariff is sent to you for filing in compliance with requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Commission regulations. This tariff is issued by Explorer Pipeline Company ("Explorer") and bears the designation F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 100.125.0. The tariff is filed to become effective on December 13, 2024.

The revisions reflected in F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 100.125.0 include:


- Updates to the Table of Contents;
- Item No. 10(b), Commodity & Specifications: updated to reference the current version of the Shipper's Manual, Section 3, Fungible Product Specifications, dated December 13, 2024;
- Item No. 118, Diluent Volume Incentive Rates to Irwin/Cochin Terminal, Illinois, Manhattan/Southern Lights Terminal, Illinois: new item setting forth a volume incentive program for any shipper that enters into and has an effective throughout and deficiency agreement with Explorer, pursuant to which the shipper agrees to make a minimum ship-or-pay volume commitment to Explorer for a term of five years, in exchange for which the shipper will qualify for certain incentive (discounted) transportation rates. Explorer notes that Item No. 118 is separate and distinct from the incentive program contemplated in Item No. 117, which, by its own terms, is an incentive program that Explorer is no longer offering and that Explorer will remove from the tariff once all existing contracts related to Item No. 117 have expired; and
- Table IVC, Diluent Volume Incentive Rates: sets forth the new incentive rates for those shippers that qualify for the new volume incentive program set forth in Item No. 118, as described above.

In addition, Explorer is filing herewith an updated version of its Shipper Manual, Section 2, Shipper Information, dated December 13, 2024, as such manual is defined and referenced in the accompanying tariff. In the updated version of Section 2 of the Shipper Manual, Explorer updates subparagraphs 2.1.1.B.vii, 2.1.6, and 2.19 regarding shipper requirements for supporting Explorer's leak detection system.

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 343.3 of the Commission's regulations, Explorer requests that any protest or other filing with regard to this tariff be sent electronically to Celeste Johnson at cjohnson@expl.com.
