Re: F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 100.133.0 cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 100.132.0 (Docket No. IS26-38-000).

Dear Secretary Reese:

The accompanying tariff is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Commission regulations. This tariff is issued by Explorer Pipeline Company ("Explorer") and bears the designation F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 100.133.0. The tariff is filed to become effective on April 10, 2026 on less than 1 days' notice.

The revisions reflected in F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 100.133.0 includes:

- Updated the issuer information on the cover page of the tariff to reflect Explorer's President & Chief Executive Officer, Mark A. Hurley; and
- Item No. 10(b), Commodity & Specifications: updated to reference the current version of the Shipper's Manual, Section 3, Fungible Product Specifications, dated April 10, 2026.

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 341.14 (Special Permission), Explorer requests that it be granted a waiver under Section 6(3) of the ICA to file F.E.R.C. No. 100.133.0 on less than 1 days' notice, so that it may become effective on April 10, 2026. Explorer submits that good cause exists for granting a waiver under Section 6(3) of the ICA. Explorer submits that no shipper should be adversely impacted by allowing F.E.R.C. No. 100.133.0 to become effective on short notice.

In addition, Explorer is filing herewith an updated version of its Shipper Manual, Section 3, Fungible Product Specifications, dated April 10, 2026, as such manual is defined and referenced in the accompanying tariff. In the updated version of Section 3 of the Fungible Product Specifications, Explorer updates the Summer and Winter product codes on pages 3-7, 3-8, 3-11 and 3-12 to comply with the EPA's temporary emergency fuel waiver. Explorer's shippers were previously notified of these changes.

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 343.3 of the Commission's regulations, Explorer requests that any protest or other filing with regard to this tariff be sent electronically to Celeste Johnson at cjohnson@expl.com.
