Dear Ms. Reese:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), Magellan Pipeline Company, L.P. (“MPL”), a subsidiary of ONEOK, Inc., submits the following tariffs effective January 1, 2026:

F.E.R.C. No. 170.49.0 cancels F.E.R.C. No. 170.48.0 (Docket No. IS26-26-000)
F.E.R.C. No. 171.41.0 cancels F.E.R.C. No. 171.40.0 (Docket No. IS25-531-000)
F.E.R.C. No. 195.1.0 cancels F.E.R.C. No. 195.0.0 (Docket No. IS23-157-000)

Explanation of Tariff Filing

MPL is filing F.E.R.C. Nos. 170.49.0, 171.41.0, and 195.1.0 to remove joint origins listed in each tariff, from which service is no longer provided, and to cancel a Quarterly Volume Incentive Program which will no longer be offered. These and other tariff changes are further explained below.

F.E.R.C. No. 170.49.0 reflects the following revisions:

- The Title Page is updated to revise the applicable C.F.R. provisions.
- Item No. 210, a Two-Year Annual Volume Incentive Program to North Little Rock, cancels the joint origin of Pasadena, TX (Phillips 66 Carrier, LLC, Pasadena, TX and Kinder Morgan Pasadena, TX) and associated volume incentive rates. The origin and rates are removed because the joint tariff service is no longer being offered. Other origins and volume incentive rates in the program to North Little Rock remain unchanged. An administrative correction is made to the origin label Pasadena-MVP, TX in the program description.
- Item No. 220, a Two-Year Incentive Program to North Little Rock, cancels the joint origin of Pasadena, TX (Phillips 66 Carrier, LLC, Pasadena, TX and Kinder Morgan

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Pasadena, TX) and associated volume incentive rates. The origin and rates are removed because the joint tariff service is no longer being offered. Other origins and volume incentive rates in the program to North Little Rock remain unchanged.

F.E.R.C. No. 171.41.0 reflects the following revisions:

- The Title Page is updated to revise the applicable C.F.R. provision.
- Item No. 250, a Quarterly Volume Incentive Program, is cancelled in its entirety because the program is no longer being offered.

F.E.R.C. No. 195.1.0 reflects the following revisions:

- The Title Page is updated to revise the applicable C.F.R. provisions. Administrative changes also have been made to wording on the Title Page.
- In Item No. 100, the origin of Pasadena, TX is cancelled. The origin is removed because the joint tariff service is no longer being offered and the joint origin is no longer part of the West Leg Reserved Capacity Program. Other origins remain unchanged in the West Leg Reserved Capacity Program.
- Administrative changes have been made to wording and to update referenced note numbers throughout the tariff.

Waiver

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 341.2(c)(1), MPL has not identified any waivers of the Commission's regulations needed to permit its filing to become effective as proposed. However, MPL respectfully requests that, should the Commission determine that any such waivers are required, the Commission grant such waivers as are necessary in order that the revised tariff records may be made effective as proposed.
